




Queen Eleanor of Castile (1246-1290)

Queen Margaret of France (1279-1318)

- I was given all of the lands that belonged to Queen Eleanor



Queen Isabella of France (1292-1358)

- I married Edward II
- I was staying in Leeds Castle when it was sieged by Lady Badlesmere



Queen Anne of Bohemia (1366-1394)

- I spent the night before my wedding, to Richard II, at Leeds Castle
- I was married very young, and lived to be very old



Queen Joan of Navarre (1370-1437)

- I married Henry IV and got on well with my stepson, Henry V
- I was accused of stealing money
- I was imprisoned at Leeds Castle



Queen Catherine de Valois (1401-1437)

- I was a Spanish Princess
- After my husband, Henry V, died, I married another king
- My grandson started the Tudor dynasty



Queen Katharine of Aragon (1485-1536)

- My husband, Henry VIII, had Leeds Castle renovated for our visit
- Henry and I remained happily married throughout our lives
- You can still see my personal emblem, an apple, in the Castle
